The Danish Fencing Federation and Roskilde Fencing Club are very thrilled and honoured to invite for the greatest regional sabre fencing party of the year - the Nordic Sabre Fencing Championship 2016 – to take place on October 22nd & 23rd at Roskilde Congress Centre in Roskilde, Denmark.

Venue: Roskilde Congress Centre, Roskilde, Denmark

(43 km from Copenhagen Airport, 1.4 km from Roskilde Railway Station)

Entry Fee: 20 EUR per individual for individual competitions,

60 EUR per registered team.

Individual Competitions: Youth: U11, U13 and U15, Cadet (U17), Junior (U20), Senior and Veteran.

Team competitions: Cadet, Senior

Participant entry: No later than October 16, 2016, online by Ophardt,

or by mail (RoskildeFaegteklub@gmail.com)

The tournament is an open tournament. We will carry out all competitions (individual/team, age and gender). Nordic Champions will be the highest ranking fencers in the competition selected according to the NFU rules.

Mission

Starting at the Nordic Sabre Championship 2015 in Iceland and continuing the dialogue in the network of Nordic sabre fencing clubs, it has been clear that the Nordic sabre community wish for the tournament to equally pursue several goals

- Of course to proclaim Nordic Champions in a tournament of a high level.
- Bring together as many *sabre* fencers as possible, to experience the volume difficult to obtain within each Nordic country alone and thus encourage further cooperation between the countries.

And especially to ensure that fencers on all levels get as much fencing experience as possible.

Nordic Sabre Championship has had quite varying number of participant during the years – the preliminary feedback from clubs in the network suggests that we could have more participants than usual this year.

Before finalizing the schedule we need the different known stakeholders to give a noncommittal overview of the expected number and distribution of fencers in advance, to enable detailed planning.

Based on that, the invitation will be updated with the detailed schedule (and formula for each competition).

The schedule will be planned to accommodate that many fencers would like to fence one class up. Fencing two classes up will in general also be possible for the individual competitions¹ upon approval.

Registration and weapon control see page 3-5 for updated or additional information

Fencers must have registered no later than 1 hour before competition start, weapon control is mandatory prior to start fencing. To ensure a smooth and timely process all fencers are encouraged to complete registration and weapon control on Friday before the competition. The preliminary schedule for this is between 17:00 and 19:30 on Friday October21st.

We think it would be great for all interested fencers, and supporters interested join for dinner (each at own expense) after the championship has closed.

In the town of Roskilde we would suggest e.g.

Hotel Scandic: 850 m. from the venue

Prindsen/Zleep Hotels: 1.400 m. from the venue

Comwell: 4.8 km. from the venue

Within 15 minutes by car or by train other accommodations are feasible.

¹ The schedule is not expected to allow for fencing two classes up when participating in teams, i.e. not allowing cadets to fence senior team.

NFU = Nordic Fencing Union

Competitions:

All competitions (classes) will be carried out if a minimum of two fencers are registered for start².

Depending on the number of starters, *U11 may be mixed gender*. All other individual competitions will be for each gender. *Teams with members from more than one federation are allowed*²

The competition schedule in general will *try* to accommodate for fencers fencing one class up (or two classes upon approval). *Exempted* from this is the senior team competition, expected to be only for junior and seniors.

As the tournament is open (we expect entries from more than 15 fencers from non-NFU federations):

- We will in each competition have Open Competition Semi-finals and Final
- We <u>may</u> have additional elimination and finals to settle Nordic Championship In this case both "Open Tournament"-gold/silver/bronze" and "Nordic Champion"-gold/silver/bronze.

The NFU rules of "The highest ranking fencers from any Nordic [= NFU member] federation is the Nordic Champion..." will be implemented as follows:

- If more than one NFU fencer/team has the same ranking³ in the open competition and applies to the same Nordic Champion medal, additional Nordic final (and if needed Nordic semi-final etc.) will be conducted.

Competitions planned (based on year of birth)

Youth: U11 (-2005), U13 (2003-2004), U15 (2001-2002)

Cadet=U17 (1999-2000) Junior=U20 (1996-1998)

Senior (-1995)

Veteran: V40 (1967-1976), V50 (1957-1966), V60 (1947-1956), V70 (1937-1946)

Formula for competitions

To pursue the mission of the competition – the part about maximizing the fencing experienced by all fencers, within the limits of the tournament (time and referees) – we will *if possible* prioritize more bouts to seniors⁴

Registration and weapon control

Fencers must have registered no later than 1 hour before tournament start.

Fencers arriving late and only fencing Sunday e.g. Veterans – can only be exempt from this rule by mail approval from lars@roark.dk.

Weapon control is mandatory prior to start fencing.

² NFU statutes apply to claim "Nordic Champion". E.g. if only 3 V50 and 3 V40 (same gender) is registered for start, an open V50 competition will be pursued for 3 fencer. And a V40 Nordic Championship for all 6 (V50 offered to join V40) veterans will be pursued as defined in NFU statutes.

³ "Same ranking" is defined as "in same stage of elimination" (1, 2, 3-4, 5-8, 9-16,).

⁴ As seniors can't benefit from participating in older classed (as e.g. juniors can)

To ensure a smooth and timely process all fencers are encouraged to complete registration and weapon control on Friday before the competition. *The preliminary schedule for this is between 17:00 and 19:30 on Friday October21*st, and from 07:15-08:00 on Saturday October 22nd - weapon control continues after 08:00.

Equipment requirements:

The official (NFU) requirements are:

Senior/Veteran/Junior/Cadet 800N-FIE: jacket, breeches and plastron. 1600N-FIE mask

U15/U13 350N jacket, 800N-FIE plastron (or plastron 350N, jacket 800N-FIE)

350N mask, breeches

U11 350N jacket, breeches, plastron, mask

Please note that the requirements of course apply NOT to the fencer, but to the competition. Thus e.g. a U15 fencer participating in Cadet Competition MUST have all 800N-FIE clothes and 1600N-FIE mask.

Blade sizes:

U11: Size 0-3

U13, U15, and Cadet: Size 0-5

older: Size 5

There are *no specific requirements* regarding print on lame.

There are *no specific requirements* to have flags on clothes.

Accommodations
