

## Covid-19 protocol and rules

The FIE and the competition organisers have put health protocols in place due to the COVID-19 pandemic in order to protect participants as much as possible.

**We appeal to your full cooperation, support, responsibility and solidarity.**

In addition to the **"FIE OUTLINE OF RISK-MITIGATION REQUIREMENTS FOR NATIONAL FENCING FEDERATIONS AND COMPETITION ORGANISERS"**, all participants are required to strictly apply the following rules:



### Covid-19 tests

- One PCR test will be performed upon arrival (day 0) of the participants.
- All participants will be tested every four days (day 4), except when day 4 is the day of departure.
- Additional rapid tests (every four days) will be performed at official hotels (see information on PCR Test Station) of participants. No isolation is required.
- If a PCR test is required to leave the host country, participants must inform the PCR Test Station in their hotel and make an appointment according to their departure time. Results of tests will be printed by the Covid-19 Officers and provided to the participants at the "Covid-19 Info desk" of each hotel.
- Wearing face masks is obligatory at any time, except while fencing, training (Individual lessons and sparring) and meals.
- Social distance of 1.5 meters must be respected at any time by all participants, including during meetings and while sitting on the tribunes.

## Accreditation

All the participants who received **a negative result** test will get a wristband which later will be exchanged for an accreditation.

- The accreditations for the participants of the competitions can be collected at Hamdan Sports Complex (Level 2) according to the accreditation desk working hours (schedule below).

## Trainings

Training sessions will only be held in the Training Halls in Hamdan Sports Complex (Level 3) according to the time and piste indicated for every National Federations.

- Wearing of facemasks and keeping 1.5 meters of social distance is obligatory when teams are in the team boxes during training.
- Fencing equipment can be kept only in team boxes.

## Preliminary competitions (Pools & Pre DE)

Only fencers, coaches, medical officials, and NF officials are allowed to be present at the competition zone:

- Warming up for fencers will take place on the pistes in the fencing hall (pistes 9-24 Level 1) keeping 1.5 meters of social distance.
- After the end of the preliminary events (pools), the fencers wait for the information which will be posted on the information boards, LED and TV screens.
- Eliminated fencers are allowed to sit at the tribunes but are not allowed to move around the competition area in the technical area of the fencing hall, around coloured pistes and pistes N°5-8,9-24. For all official meetings, 1.5 meters distance must be applied.
- Hand shaking before and after a bout or a team match is not allowed.
- Armed hand salute must be applied.
- Coaches on the pistes must stay at a 1.5 meter from the fencers and must wear face masks in

tables T128, 64,32,16 etc. (during the 1-minute break).

- Participants are allowed to sit on the tribunes during the preparation for the competition and as spectators, but they must keep a distance of 1.5 metres.
- Wearing a facemask and keeping 1.5 meters of social distance is obligatory when teams are in the team boxes during training.

Fencing equipment and fencing bags should be placed in the tribunes. Fencing bags may not be placed on the field of play. Preliminary competitors (pools and DE) should only store their fencing bags in the team boxes.

## Table 32 and Final

- According to the updated information on the information boards and technical schedule of each weapon, fencers must be present in the Call Room 20 minutes prior the start of T32-Final for weapon control and follow the instructions of the Call room staff and FIE officials. Use of facemasks in the Call Room is obligatory.
- The coaches are forbidden in the Call Room.
- The coaches will be invited to watch T32 and will stay in a Waiting area.
- It is obligatory for coaches to wear a facemask.
- Warming up for the fencers will be arranged in the fencing halls Level 1&2 (pistes N°25-32).

## The Medal Ceremonies

- During medal ceremonies, medals and other awards will not be handed to the fencers but presented on a cushion. Facemasks may be removed during photo ceremony.

## Consequences

Any breach of the Covid-19 protocol potentially harms other participants. Covid Officers and officials will report such cases to the "Covid-19 Compliance Committee". Refusing to follow the Covid-19 protocol and repeated or multiple breaches will be sanctioned by the withdrawal of the accreditation.

## Confirmation and Accreditation

- The accreditation office and system will remain operational until the end of the World Championships (10 April 2022).
- Neither the fencers nor the coaches will have access to the competition area without their valid accreditations.
- The attendance of a fencer is confirmed once he is registered at the FIE website.
- The participation of athletes in individual and team events is validated when collecting their accreditation, no later than 14h00 the day before athletes have their first competition.
- Fencers do not need to present themselves at the Directoire Technique.
- Federations who have not yet made their payments are asked to settle their accounts with FIE Secretary Treasurer Mrs. Salhi or FIE by 12h00 on 1 April 2022.
- The accreditations will be distributed personally for each participant, upon payment of their entry fees.

- The Directoire Technique must be notified of any changes related to the teams by 16h00 the day prior to the event.
- Direct Elimination tables of 64-32 will be posted in the Competition Venue (Information point, TV LED, Web site [fie.org](http://fie.org) / [dubaiwfc.com](http://dubaiwfc.com)) on the QR on your accreditation and official hotels the day preceding the team event at 17h00.
- Preliminary tables T32-16 will be fenced in coloured pistes and N° 5-8/9-24 Hamdan Sports Complex (Level 1)
- Final Direct Elimination tables of 8 will be posted immediately in the Competition



# Competition venue

Hamdan Sports Complex (Level 1-3) **is subdivided into:**


**Level 1** - Final's Hall is equipped with 8 color pistes with video system refereeing and Final podium (see plan of competition below) this is the final piste (Podium);

- Pistes for preliminary competitions are equipped with 24+4 and more pistes on Level 2 (see plan of competition venue below).



- The eight (8) coloured pistes (Level 1) with video "Fencing Vision"
- Call Room - Level 1, under the tribunes next to the Mixed Zone (see the plan)
- Referees Room Level 1 under the tribunes next to the Call Room (see the plan)
- Medical Room and 2 medical stations - Level 1 under the tribunes next to the Call Room & on each side of the field of play.
- Info Desk & LED screen (location) & TV LED on each side of the field of play.
- Directoire technique - Final Hall (Level1, under the tribunes near the Podium)



### **Training halls & team boxes for Nation Federations**

- Training Hall **Level 3:** - 14 pistes
- Size of the boxes will be selected to accommodate 14 pistes and requires social distancing.
- Training Hall will have independent entrance the control of the accreditation.



- Team Boxes for the participating teams (1.5 x 2.5m) will be located next to pistes for training, inside the venue (Level 3).
- The Training Hall is open from 30 March to 10 April: 09h00-18h00
- The pistes in the training hall will not will be used for warm-up.

## VIII Access to the Fencing Area

- Only the designated fencers, referees and pistes staff are granted access to the pistes.
- No access will be granted to the coloured pistes, podium fencing area, team boxes without sport shoes and long pants.
- Athletes in the fencing area must keep their belongings in closed fencing bags at the end of the piste.
- Fencing bags are not accepted in the competition area

### Individual competitions (Pools):

- the coach, the team captain, the official representative of team are forbidden to be in a zone of carrying out pools, is not allowed to remain in a team box.

## Individual competitions DE:

- One coach per athlete and per piste is allowed to stay in the team box.
- Athletes should be present in Call Room 20 minutes prior to the beginning of the DE-T32 (the first check of weapon control)
- Coaches cannot be present in Call Room.

## Team events juniors:

- The team captain and one more person are allowed to stay in the box reserved for teams. (6 persons max)

## All athletes and referees must be present:

- on the piste 15 minutes before the beginning of the pools
- on the piste 10 minutes before the beginning of the match Pre DE(T128-T64)
- athletes should be present in the Call room 20 minutes before the beginning of T32
- **Athletes should be present in the Call Room 20 minutes before the beginning of the ceremony of presentation of the athletes (FINAL)**

## Requirements regarding the equipment

- All the equipment must be in good condition and working order complying with FIE regulations and will be checked under control of the FIE SEMI commission and all the fencers of the same team have to be the same. The list of accepted items is mentioned in the table below.
- It is mandatory to put the logos of the countries on both legs of the breeches.
- The name of the athlete and the name of the country must be printed in dark blue color on the back; the size of the letters should be between 8 and 10 cm high. All the prints must be readable. The possibility to put the names will be available at the venue.
- All the advertising and manufacturer logos must be in conformity with the FIE Publicity Code requirements and will be checked.
- After collecting the equipment, it is necessary for the athletes to check the presence of the control markings.
- For additional information, please, see m.38.1.2.3.4.5., m.39 1.2.3. of the FIE Material Rules.

## Electric jackets

The conductive jacket must be made so that when it is laid flat there is a straight line between the point of junction of the lines of the groin and the two points corresponding to the tops of the hip bones (ilium).

### The Control of electric jackets will be carried out in two steps:

- Firstly, in the Weapon Control room checking the respective electrical parameters and geometric dimensions
- For the second time, the electric jackets will be checked in the Call Room in the presence of a representative of the Referees, while the athlete is wearing the jacket. The purpose is to check whether the electric jacket fits athlete's body.

## Breast/chest protectors

- The use of a breast/chest protector (made of metal or some rigid material – see m.25.4) is compulsory for women and optional for men. At foil, this breast/chest protector with a special soft layer must be worn below the protective plastron.
- The soft layer has to be approved by FIE SEMI and have the FIE logo.

## Mask

- All the participants to this Juniors and Cadets Championships have to fully comply with the new rule concerning the new fastening system of the mask (see m.25.7)

## Mask designs

- Masks may feature coloured designs, on condition that they are approved by the FIE.

## XI

### Confirmation of results

- The fencers are responsible for checking if the results in their pool and the DE sheets are recorded correctly. The screens placed in different locations will allow a quick verification of the updated results of the round of pools and DE matches.
- To avoid any kind of error the DT will publish the results of the pools and the list of qualified and eliminated fencers as soon as the round of pools is over. Delegations must submit any protest to the DT within 10 minutes. After this deadline, the ranking will not be modified.
- The DE tables, together with the schedule and pistes, will be posted after this 10 - minutes period and after each round of DE.
- Only documents presented at the information stand are official (result of preliminary competitions of groups, an individual ranking).
- No calls will be made via microphone.

## XII

### Organisation of the individual direct elimination table t32

- For T32 all fencers must be present in the official warm-up area (halls 2-4) 40 minutes before the scheduled beginning of their matches.
  - Fencers must report to the Call Room 20 minutes before the scheduled beginning of their matches to be led to the coloured pistes at the scheduled time.
  - Coaches are not allowed to be in the Call Room
    - **The wireless system will not be used at the WCH J&C.**
  - The bag is to remain closed for the entirety and put in the team box under the supervision of the volunteer. During the one-minute break, or when it is needed, the volunteer will bring to the athlete a chair and the spare weapon. Athletes are to leave the Call Room ready to fence, mask in hand and weapon already plugged into their body wires.
- Attention! In case the team does not report to the Call Room at the appointed time (according to time specified in the schedule) the sanction in the rules (art t.118-119) will apply.**

## XIII

# Organisation of the team direct elimination table

- For the T64, T32 and T16 teams must report to the piste 10 minutes before the scheduled beginning of their bouts.
  - All teams taking part in a final stage of tournament (N<sup>o</sup>8-T4) must be present in Call room 25 minutes before the beginning of the tournament.
  - Equipment Control in the Call Room will be from T4 (in earlier stages equipment control will be made on the pistes)
  - Equipment will be controlled in the team boxes during the matches N<sup>o</sup>8-N<sup>o</sup>4-Finale.
  - The teams will have designated areas, sectioned off by barriers, near the coloured pistes and pistes N<sup>o</sup> 5-8, 9-30, 30-32, Team members must remain within these areas during the team matches.
- Attention! In case the fencer does not report to the Call Room at the appointed time (according to time specified in the schedule) the sanction in the rules (art t.118-119) will apply.**

# Video refereeing

- Video-refereeing is used in all three weapons from the T32 (juniors & cadet) at the **individual** events
- **video refereeing** is used from T16 in junior team events (sabre, foil)
- **video refereeing** is used from T8 in junior team events (epee)
- The designation of referees and video - consultants is done according to art. t.49 - t.51 of the Technical Rules.
