II. COMPETITION VENUE

Ocean Center Convention Center Address: 101 N. Atlantic Ave., Daytona Beach, FL 32118

The Ocean Center is a modern, state-of-the-art, multipurpose facility located in the heart of Daytona Beach, FL. The venue is just a short walk from the accommodations arranged for the 2023 Veteran World Championships, only 400 feet from the world-renowned Daytona Beach, and provides easy access to a variety of shops and entertainment.

Named the 2019 Stella Gold Award Winner for Best Convention Center in the Southeast, the Ocean Center opened in 1985 and was expanded in 2009, doubling the facility's size. It features more than 200,000 square feet of flexible indoor and outdoor meeting space

The Ocean Center incorporates sun, sand, surf and speed into its fourteen Art in Public Places works. In February 2015, the center installed the NASCAR Stock Car Hall of Fame exhibit to pay tribute to the area's rich racing history. The exhibit honors legendary drivers and personalities in stock car racing, and includes photos and plaques of 58 inductees.

III. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be open according to the following schedule:

Participants cannot be allowed to use equipment control, the training venue, competition halls, or any other facility without accreditation. Participants or their head of delegation can collect the accreditation(s) after showing proof of bank transfer or paying the entry fees required onsite. If payment is made on site, it may only be by cash or credit card.

IV. SPECTATOR ADMISSION

For spectators, admission will be \$5 USD per day. Full event passes allowing admission on all competition days will be available for \$25 USD. Tickets are available for pre-purchase by <u>clicking here</u>. Please note to pre-purchase, you will be required to enter a credit card or information for a US bank account. Tickets will also be able to be purchased onsite at Registration desk in the Ocean Center Lobby with credit card or cash. If you purchase your tickets online, please be sure to bring a copy of your confirmation email for verification.

V. REGISTRATION & PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES

All participating athletes are required to have an FIE License for 2022/23, per the FIE Statutes and Administrative rules.

REGISTRATION

The registration of athletes and officials from the delegations must be done through the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE Rules and the quotas of delegations. Photos of athletes and officials from the delegations registered on the FIE website must be uploaded on the FIE website.

Also, entries must be sent to the organizers by the competitors' national federation. Entries must be sent no later than one month before the beginning of the championship.

VII. ACCESS TO COMPETITION AREAS

- Only the designated fencers, referees and pistes staff are granted access to the pistes.
- No access will be granted to the coloured pistes, podium fencing area, team boxes without sport shoes and long pants.
- Athletes in the fencing area must keep their belongings in closed piste bags (without wheels) at the end of the piste.
- Individual competitions (Pools): Only the athletes are permitted to be inside the barriers surrounding the competition areas.
- Individual competitions DE :
 - One coach per athlete and per piste is allowed to stay in the coach's box.
 - Athletes should be present in Call Room 20 minutes prior
 - to the beginning DE T8 (the first check weapon control)
 - Athletes are the only persons permitted in the call room.
- Team Events:
- One team captain and one coach is allowed to stay in the box reserved for teams. (Up to 6 athletes)
- All athletes and referees must be present:
 - On the piste 15 minutes before the beginning of the pools
 - On the piste 10 minutes before the beginning of the match DE (T128, T64, T32, T16, T8, T4)
 - Athletes should be present in the Call room 20 minutes before the beginning of the bronze and gold medal match

VIII. CONFIRMATION OF RESULTS

- The fencers are responsible for checking if the results in their pool and the DE sheets are recorded correctly. The screens placed in different locations will allow a quick verification of the updated results of the round of pools and DE matches.
- The DT will publish the results of the pools and the list of qualified and eliminated fencers as soon as the round of pools is over. Delegations must submit any protest to the DT within 10 minutes. After this deadline, the ranking will not be modified.
- All fencers will advance from pools to the DE tables, and the DT will publish the results and rankings after the conclusion of the pools.
- The DE tables, together with the schedule and pistes, will be posted after the 10 minute period and after each round of DE.
- Only documents presented at the information stand are official (result of preliminary competitions of groups, an individual ranking).
- No calls will be made via microphone.

IX. VIDEO REFEREEING

- Video-refereeing is used in all three weapons from the T8 at the individual events
- Video refereeing is used for the bronze and gold medal matches in the team events.

X. MEDAL CEREMONY

- Athletes must present at the podium area 10 min before the designated time for the awards ceremony
- Athletes must wear their warm ups and sports shoes for the ceremony no shorts will be permitted.

XI. EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

- All the equipment must comply with FIE regulations and will be checked under control of the FIE SEMI commission and all the fencers of the same team have to be the same.
- It is mandatory to put the logos of the countries on both legs of the breeches. The surname of the athlete and the name of the country must be printed on the back of the jacket and/or electric jacket.
- All the advertising and manufacturer logos must be in conformity with the FIE Publicity Code requirements and will be checked.

- During the tournament there will be the opportunity to print a name and nationality of fencers on the back of the jacket.

XII. TRAVEL/VISA REQUESTS

<u>If you do need a visa, please urgently apply</u>. It can take several weeks to or more to obtain a visa if you are traveling from non-WWP countries.

Once you have applied please note your DS-160 number, you will then need to pay the visa fee to the US Government, following the instructions.

After applying, you should select the earliest available appointment date (even if beyond the date of travel), then if needed can re-enter the scheduling system and select the "Request Expedite" option. If this still does not result in a satisfactory appointment date, please reach out to us at the contact details below.

Though it is not required to have a visa invitation letter for the interview process, we are happy to provide one, in order to provide this or any other assistance, we need you to fill out the form available here: <u>2023 FIE Veteran World Championship</u> <u>Visa Invitation Letter</u>. It is important to receive your ESTA or Visa as appropriate as soon as possible. Delegations are encouraged to make this their highest priority.

The ESTA or VWP may be used by the following nations except where an individual has visited the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (North Korea, DPRK), Islamic Republic of Iran, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria or Yemen. You may not use the VWP if you are also a dual national of PRK, IRI, Iraq, Sudan or Syria. You may not use the VWP if you have a criminal record.

Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Chile, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Lichenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Republic of Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Chinese Taipei and the United Kingdom.

When the head of delegation collects the accreditations, we will kindly ask you to sign a form to confirm that the anthem and flag emailed to us match the ones you want to be used during the World Championships.

TIME ZONE
