If the number of participants will exceed 36, the event will be held on two days and in that case starts on Friday June 27th with Fencing and Swimming .

Rules

The event is organised according to the UIPM-rules

Additional information

- According to UIPM-rules all participants must be a member of a national pentathlon federation or covering institution
- By registration Participants accept the rejection of all claims concerning liability, finance or other, lost properties, injuries and/or illness, etcetera. The participant has to take care of his/her own insurance(s)
- Included in the participation fee is the use of a horse. Other costs, such as costs for board, and lodging and food, are for participants
- There is no limit to the number of participants per country and no minimum or maximum of participants for the event.

The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM rules

- Swimming: 25 meter indoor 6 lane pool
- Fencing: 6 pistes
- Combined event: 4.5 mm compressed air pistol (no laser). Pistols with air



- like propelling charge, can be transported free of permits. Shooting is done on a single target with electronic hit registration.
- Running part: the surface of the running track is mainly grass
- Riding: Participants are obliged to use a body protector. Body protectors are available and can be used free of charge

Travel and Lodging

The Netherlands have outstanding travel connections by air, car, train and bus. Athletes, coaches and spectators need to make their own travel arrangements to, between and from competition venues. The organization recommends two hotels: one situated at the accommodation of the National Sports Center Papendal, itself and the other is situated on at a 100 meters distance of the sports center.

Athlete license

Athletes can only have their scores registered with the UIPM if they are in possession of a valid UIPM-issued Athlete License, in which case athletes must bring this license to the competition. Otherwise, athletes are requested to bring their national license.

Visa and vaccinations

Visiting participants should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into the Netherlands prior to travelling to the event. For further information please contact your Embassy or Consulate. The Royal Netherlands Shooting Sport Association does not accept responsibility for arranging visas but will be able to provide letters of invitation, upon request.

Registration fee

The registration fee to participate in the Dutch Open Coubertin Cup 2014 amounts to € 10.00, per event per athlete. When the athlete participates in the Pentathlon we charge an additional fee for the use of a horse of € 30.00. The



registration fee should be paid in advance; participants will receive an invoice. If the situation occurs that the registration has to be declined, The Royal Netherlands Shooting Sport Association will immediately reimburse any prepaid fees.
