FIE-rules and SvFF – tournament rules of December 1st 2014 including security regulations. The mask must have the new type of bib for foil fencing.

Formula

The competitions rules and regulations are based on FIE REG., SvFF TB and the Swedish Masters ruling book - <http://www.fencing.se/om-faktning/tavlingar/tavlingsbestammelser/>
Poule systems depending on the number of fencers and then direct elimination.
(Hopefully two poule rounds and then direct elimination for all fencers).

Entry fee

15 Euro or 150 SEK per capita or by double start 25 Euro or 250 SEK, which can be paid at the registration in the hall.

Weapon and security control

Please note that the metal vest and mask must be checked and will be given an approval mark. This control is open Friday from 18:00 to 20:00 and Saturday and Sunday from 7:15 in the hall. Due to SvFF competition rules additional inspections will be conducted by the referee on the piste.

Each club, Swedish or foreign, who with five starts or more (during the whole weekend) must have referee/s available during the tournament. A penalty of SEK 1500 or Euro 150 must be paid for each referee, a club cannot present in accordance with the stipulations above. Any fines must be paid before the tournament of the day begins.

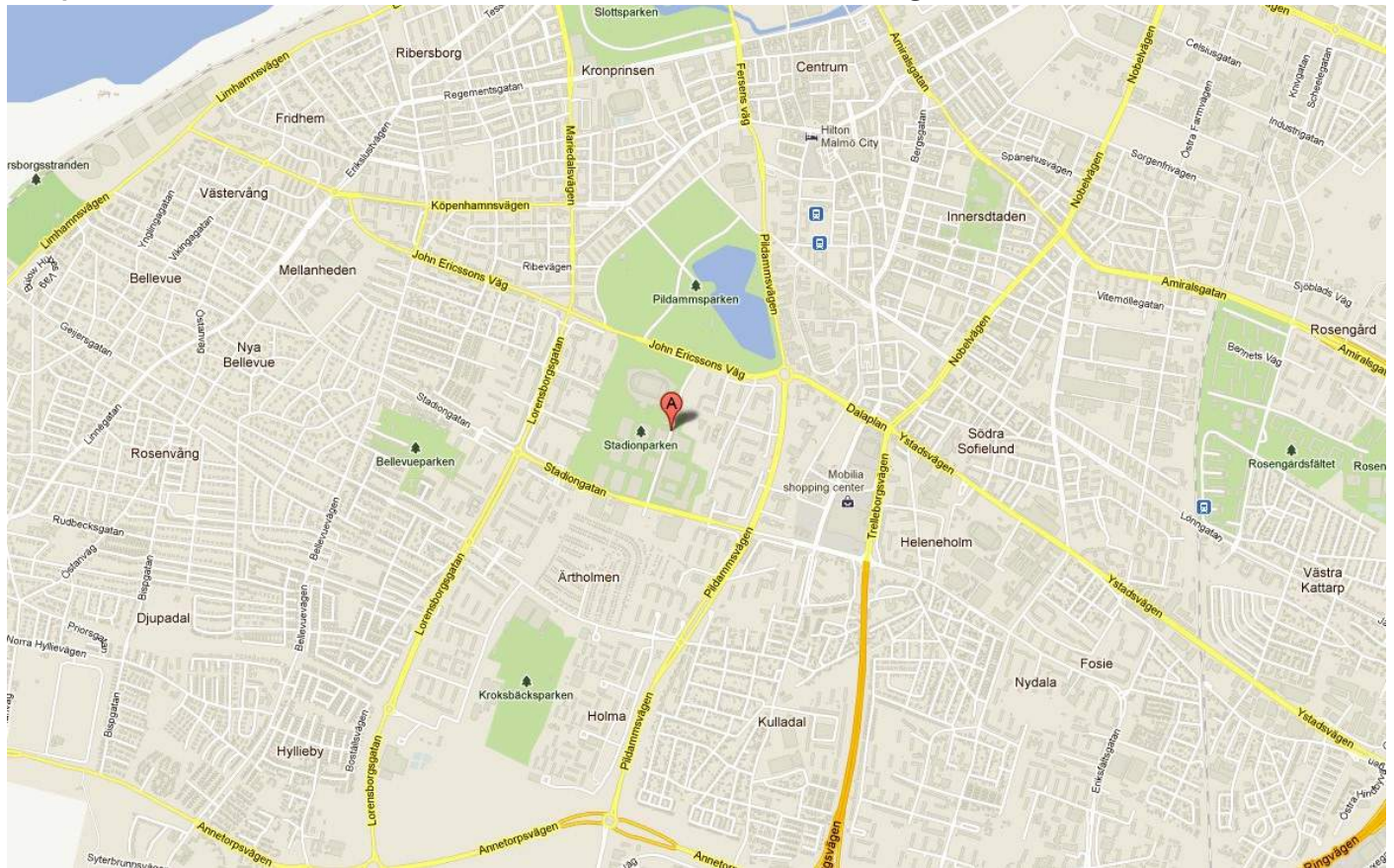
