Competition Rules The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules at the facilities of University of Limerick

Swimming: 50m indoor swimming pool / 8 lanes

Fencing: 10 pistes indoor (including 1 reserve) – FBR indoor.

Combined Event: 36+2 precision laser targets (Enclosed Cover). Running course: track and grass.

Training The LOC will offer training opportunities for swimming only on Wednesday, 14 July 2016. Please contact the organizing committee for details on arrival.

Accommodation All teams will be accommodated on **campus at the University of Limerick**. The reservation for the accommodation will be on first come first serve basis.

Transport

Transportation from **Dublin Airport or Shannon Airport** to the official competition accommodation and the return journey is only guaranteed if flight information is provided in the registration system in good time and prior to the deadline. Transportation from the official accommodation to the venues for athletes will be according to the competition programme.

Financial Conditions

As approved by the UIPM all delegation members (including athletes, coaches, and officials) will pay per day as follows:

- €140 for a single room (Double Bed) per night per person.

This price includes entry to the competition, full board accommodation, local transportation from/to the event and shuttle from/to **Dublin Airport/Shannon Airport**.

Delegations wishing to arrange their own accommodation must pay an accreditation fee per participant (athlete, coach or official) to the LOC. In accordance with UIPM Rule 1.15.2, the amount of the Accreditation fee is set at €50.00 per day per person with a minimum payment of 4 days (€200.00). For this, we will provide lunch packets for the competition days and allow access to official transportation between the competition hotel and competition sites

Deadlines

Delegations are reminded that the UIPM online registration system must be used to submit all entry and accreditation information. All information must be submitted, including flight information, pistol serial numbers, accommodation bookings, etc.

Following closure of the registration system on **13 June 2016**, a NF must enter the competition with the confirmed number of athletes and officials, only names of participants could be subject to change.

Any failure to take part after having sent their final entries will pay a fine of 600 EUR to the UIPM.

If we do not receive the payments and entry information in conjunction with the deadline listed then we will consider your delegation as non-participating.

A 10% late payment surcharge will be added for delegations failing to adhere to the final payment deadline of **27 June 2016**. Please note that under no circumstances will cash payments be accepted to pay fees on arrival at the event.

All bank fees or commissions must be paid by the sender.

As a reminder, if on arrival for the competition, the team has fewer athletes and/or officials than submitted in the registration system and without informing the Organising Nation/LOC at least 7 days prior to their arrival, the NF will pay a fine to the Organising Nation/LOC of €200.00 for each person not attending.

Athletes Licenses

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in possession of a valid Athletes Licence. Registration is not possible without a Licence Number. If an athlete does not have a licence they will not be allowed to take part in the competition.

Insurance

According to UIPM rules all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury or illness. The organizers **will not** accept any responsibility, financial or other, for any loss, injury or illness of any member of the delegation.

Laser Pistols

Firearms licences are a legal requirement when bringing air and CO2 pistols (cylinders for the laser pistols) into Ireland for competition purposes. So, please note the pistol model and serial number clearly in the registration system in order to make the necessary Entering and Exiting licences.

VISAS & Vaccinations

Visiting NFs should confirm visa requirements for entry into Ireland prior travelling to the event. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can

provide specific letters of invitation if needed. If you need an invitation letter for your Visa to enter Ireland please contact us at info@pentathlon.ie.

For information on whether you need a visa please contact your nearest Embassy or Consulate.
