All participants must have an active EFC license.

Registration for international participants

Through the EFC website before Sunday 25th January, 2026 by the national fencing federations.
Late entry surcharge: EUR 50 per fencer.

Entry fees

- EUR 25 per fencer

Competition formula

- **Individual:** 1 round of pools followed by direct elimination with approx. 80% promoted. No fence-off for third place.
- **Team:** Direct elimination with all places fenced in top 8.

Equipment control

Equipment control for **masks, gloves, bodycords and epees** will take place at the competition venue **on Friday 30th January from 18:00 to 21:00** as well as on Saturday and Sunday before the start of the competitions. Uniforms and under plastrons will be checked on piste.

Fencing equipment vendor Allstar Finland will be present with limited inventory on Friday evening only.



Referee quota for international participants

Based on total number of entries for the day.

Individual:

- 1–3 entries: not required
- 4–9 entries: 1 referee
- 10–15 entries: 2 referees
- 16 and above entries: 3 referees

Team:

- 1–2 teams: 1 referee
- 3 and above teams: 2 referees

EUR 500 sanction per every missing referee.

Referee quota for Finnish clubs

Based on total number of entries for the day.

Individual:

- 0–4 entries: not required
- 5–7 entries: 1 referee
- 8–14 entries: 2 referees
- 15 and above entries: 3 referees

Team:

- 1 team: not required
- 2–3 teams: 1 referee
- 4 and above teams: 2 referees

EUR 200 sanction per every missing referee.

All referees must be registered through the EFC website, must be at least national referees and have an active EFC licence.

Mandatory referee meeting at the venue at 9:00 on both competition days.

The referees are expected to Be available the entire day.

Prizes

Individual:

- Medals, diplomas and gifts for the top 4.
- Diplomas and gifts for the 5th to 8th places.

Team:

- Medals, diplomas and gifts for the top 3.

Medical assistance

Medical staff will be present at the competition venue during the tournament.
